LECOM Logo Usage Guidelines

The LECOM logo is a visible representation of our brand. To ensure consistent usage across the institution, please use the LECOM logo in accordance with the following standards:

- Students may use the logos from these PowerPoint slides for presentations, research posters, and for designing mockups of student club/organization fundraising projects.
- Do not attempt to create your own LECOM logo or alter the logo in any way. All logos and variations of the logos (color, size, filetype) are created by the communications and marketing department.
- The use of the LECOM logo or any variations thereof (outside of the use of research posters), must be approved by the Institutional Director of Communications and Marketing prior to printing, distributing or selling any items.
- Logos are available in blue (preferred), black, and white never alter the color of the logo. Choose
 the color that works best in context. For example, if the background resembles a shade of blue,
 use the white logo.

LECOM Logo Usage Guidelines – Available Logos

The LECOM logo is available in three versions, blue, black, and white. When reproducing the logo on white backgrounds, use the blue (preferred) or black style below. When reproducing the logo on a darker background, use a reversed, white version of the logo. **Do not** use a gray version of the logo on a white background.













LECOM Logo Usage Guidelines – What Not To Do

The LECOM logo must be used as it is sent and cannot be altered or styled in any way whatsoever.

The examples below are practices that should be avoided.







DON'T ALTER THE LOGO

DON'T SQUISH THE LOGO

DON'T CHANGE THE FONTS OR COLORS

DON'T REMOVE ELEMENTS



DON'T PLACE THE LOGO ON A SIMILAR COLOR BACKGROUND



DON'T STRETCH THE LOGO



DON'T ROTATE THE LOGO



DON'T ADD ANY KIND OF EFFECTS, I.E. DROP SHADOWS, STROKES, GRADIENTS, BEVELS, ETC., TO THE LOGO

LECOM Logo Usage Guidelines – Safe Space and Alignment

Blue indicates the logo safe space. The blue area must be kept free of competing text or other graphic elements. Grey padding indicates Safe Zone. The required logo safe space is defined by the width of the 'L' in LECOM.

Magenta indicates type and element alignment and boundaries.



The LECOM Blue and LECOM Silver colors are based on the Pantone color matching system. This is a standardized color matching system, utilizing the Pantone numbering system for identifying colors. By standardizing the colors, different manufacturers in different locations can all reference a Pantone numbered color, making sure colors match without direct contact with one another. Conversions for digital (RGB), print (CMYK) and web (Hex & Web Safe) are listed. Please use the appropriate color for your desired application.
